OF INTENT TO IMPOUND UNAUTHORIZED LIVESTOCK

(Reference FSM 5330)

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to Regulation of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 CFR 262.10, all unauthorized livestock found upon National Forest System lands or other lands under Forest Service control within the following area may be impounded by the United States Forest Service on or after *November 01, 2021* unless said livestock are removed permanently from the described lands.

All persons not wanting their unauthorized livestock gathered must remove them from the impoundment area before the gathering occurs.

After the impoundment, owners of unauthorized livestock may regain possession thereof only by first showing proof of ownership and reimbursing the United States in full for the expense incurred in impounding, feeding, and care of such livestock, or if impoundment costs exceed fair market value, by a payment equal to the fair market value of the impounded livestock. All impounded animals not redeemed within 5 days after notice of sale of impounded livestock has been published in a local newspaper, posted in the county court house and in one or more local post offices, will be offered for sale at public auction.

Livestock not sold at public sale may be sold at private sale or condemned and destroyed, or otherwise disposed of as provided by Regulation 36 CFR 262.10(f).
