On April 17, 2012 John Kiefer and you discussed your 2012 Annual Operating Instructions (AOI) for the Arab Allotment. The pasture rotation and numbers discussed are as follows:

<u>Pasture</u>	<u>Numbers</u>	<u>Dates</u>
Aniceto	27 hd c/c	June 1 to July 31
Buckwheat	27 hd	August 1 to September 30
Jackson	27 hd	October 1 to October 31

The Butler pasture will be rested this season. The utilization monitoring done during 2011 was reviewed and discussed. You also received a map of the key areas and the key species. The desired utilization level is 25% to 35% on key species in the key areas and we would like to monitor utilization with you after the livestock leave a pasture.

Any new fence construction will need an archaeological clearance. Please coordinate any new range improvement construction with Kendell, John or Andy. By this letter, I also authorize you or persons employed by you, to cut or remove any trees needed for fence posts and stays for maintenance of range improvements on the Arab allotment. A copy of this letter must be in possession while engaged in any tree cutting.
