MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) FOR RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AND NON-USE AGREEMENT

Between

Prescott National Forest, Bradshaw Ranger District (USDA, Forest Service)
And

Tres Bees LLC, Holder of Term Grazing Permit for Burnt Ranch, Cold Springs and Board Creek Allotments

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to provide a means by which the parties involved can cooperatively provide for the repair and maintenance of range developments on these allotments without jeopardizing permittee's Term Permit permitted numbers. This MOU is designed to provide flexibility and cooperation. Either party can at any time request modification or cancellation of this agreement with 30 day written notice.

STATEMENT OF MUTUAL BENEFIT AND INTERESTS: The Prescott National Forest, and Tres Bees LLC, are each committed to the proper management and improvement of range, watershed, riparian and wildlife habitat resource within the Burnt Ranch, Cold Springs, and Board Creek Allotments. Each entity recognizes that there are limitations to each other's resources, authority, administration, and management direction. It is also recognized that due to the current non-functioning condition of many of the range improvements on the allotment coupled with the extreme drought conditions at this time, effective livestock grazing is contingent upon the repair of fences and waters to functional condition.

FOREST SERVICE SHALL:

- 1) Waive the requirement to validate the permit by stocking 90% of permitted numbers for the duration of this agreement.
- 2) Authorize Resource Protection non-use up to 100% per year, per allotment, until range improvements have been returned to functional condition and condition has been verified by Forest Service personnel.
- 3) Provide no less than one mile of fence material (steel posts, wire, staples, and clips) and an administrative free use permit for posts and stays, for *reconstruction* of fences per year.
- 4) Provide additional fence and other materials as funding available, and replacement is necessary.

PERMITTEE SHALL:

- 1) Take Resource Protection non-use on Burnt Ranch Cold Springs and Board Creek Allotments, until range improvements are functioning and inspected in several pastures. The maximum authorized use will be 35 head of cattle (Cow/calf) yearlong until all range improvements are functioning and inspected by Forest Service personnel. As range improvements are returned to functional condition, permittee may request increases in authorized cattle numbers. Livestock increases will be authorized by the Forest Service as monitoring and inspections dictate appropriate. Stocking to full permitted numbers (72 head cattle yearlong on Burnt Ranch, 167 cattle yearlong on Cold Springs, 120 cattle from 11/16 to 5/15 on Board Creek) will not occur until all assigned improvements are in functioning condition.
- 2) Proceed with due diligence to repair, maintain, and or reconstruct assigned range developments to accomplish the schedule listed below.
