On January 14, 2013 you met with Kendell, John and Andy to discuss your 2013 Annual Operating Instructions for the Clay Springs Allotment. The pasture rotation and numbers as discussed are as follows:

<u>Pasture</u>	<u>Head</u>	<u>Dates</u>
Town	18	March 1 to April 1
+IL	18	April 2 to May 1
Summer North	18	May 2 to May 31
Summer North	32	June 1 to August 1
Summer South	32	August 2 to October 31
+IL	18	November 1 to December 15
Town	18	December 16 to February 1, 2014
Power Line	18	February 2 to February 28, 2014

Adjustments to this rotation and numbers may be needed during the grazing season due to resource conditions. This letter serves as your Annual Operating Instructions for the 2013 grazing year. This letter also authorizes you to cut juniper trees for stays and fence posts on the Clay Springs Allotment to be used to maintain Forest Service fences.
