Dear Permittee:

On July 23, 2019, Andy met with you to discuss the 2019 Annual Operating Instructions for the Clear Creek Allotment. The pasture rotation and numbers agreed upon are as follows:

<u>Pasture</u>	<u>Head</u>	<u>Dates</u>
East North	125 cow/calf	August 17 to September 13
North	125 cow/calf	September 14 to October 21

The South Pasture will be rested this year. The desired utilization level for the 2019 grazing season will be 30% on key species within key areas. Adjustments to this rotation may be needed during the grazing season to accommodate to changing conditions. This letter will serve as your Annual Operating Instructions for the 2019 grazing year.

Please keep salt and supplement at least a ¼ mile from water sources and in areas that help to improve distribution of cattle.

By this letter, I also authorize you and ranch personnel to cut, use, or remove any trees needed for fence posts and stays for maintenance of structural range improvements within the Clear Creek Allotment. A copy of this letter must be in possession by you or them while engaged in any tree cutting related to this activity.
