Dear Permittee:

On July 19, 2023, Andy spoke with Jim over the phone to discuss the 2023 Annual Operating Instructions for the Clear Creek Allotment. The pasture rotation and numbers agreed upon are as follows:

<u>Pasture</u>	<u>Head</u>	<u>Dates</u>
North	125 cow/calf	August 16 to September 17
South	125 cow/calf	September 18 to October 31

The East Pasture will be rested this year. The desired utilization level for the 2023 grazing season will be 30% on key species within key areas. Adjustments to this rotation may be needed during the grazing season to accommodate to changing conditions. Any adjustments to the rotation need to be coordinated with and approved by the Forest Service in advance. This letter will serve as your Annual Operating Instructions for the 2023 grazing year.

By this letter, I also authorize you and ranch personnel to cut, use, or remove any trees needed for fence posts and stays for maintenance of structural range improvements within the Clear Creek Allotment. A copy of this letter must be in possession by you or them while engaged in any tree cutting related to this activity on the Allotment.
