

Dear (b) (6),

After reviewing your requested annual operating instructions (AOI) modification following the Telegraph fire I have approved your request provided the following stipulations are met.

You are permitted to graze up to 80 head of cattle in Home, 66, Exchange and Antive pastures beginning on September 1st, 2021 with an exit date of February 28th, 2022 or earlier if utilization is met. These dates are set to coincide with the end of the grazing year on February 28th, 2022 and will be revisited during your annual meeting with us this winter to discuss grazing year 2022 annual operating instructions. Monitoring will continue as scheduled, and USFS utilization standards will be met. If utilization levels exceed 50% we will work with you to decide on a course of action that will move cattle from that pasture.

Our intent is to meet the Forest Service mission of sustaining grazing conditions on this allotment in the long term. As the Telegraph Fire burn area recovers, we will continue to manage each allotment individually to reintroduce cattle at the earliest possible date that insures long term forage productivity on the land scape.

This letter supersedes any AOI modifications prior to this date.
