Dear Mr. and Mrs. Auza:

This letter is to serve as Amendment #1 to the 2018 Annual Operating Instructions (AOI) for the Cowboy Tank, Squaw Mountain and Twin Tanks Allotments. This amendment, and the original AOI (dated May 7, 2018), are part of your Term Grazing Permit as provided for in Part 2, section 8(a). The Authorized Livestock Number/Season of Use (Section I), and the Grazing Schedule (Section II) are the only amendments made to the original AOI; all other sections and instructions remain unchanged.

On May 7, 2018 I authorized the following:

Allotment	Number of Livestock	Period of Use
Twin Tanks	500 Cattle (Cow/calf)	05/21 to 07/01
Squaw Mountain	500 Cattle (Cow/calf)	07/02 to 08/15
Cowboy Tanks	500 Cattle (Cow/calf)	08/16 to 10/20

On May 14, 2018 you contacted Mandy Ball to discuss resource conditions and lack of water on Cowboy Tank, Squaw Mountain and Twin Tanks Allotments. It was determined that due to current resource conditions and lack of water, you would not turn livestock out on these allotments. I am authorizing non-use for resource protection for the following (changes from the original authorization are in red):

Allotment	Number of Livestock	Period of Use
Twin Tanks	0	Rested
Squaw Mountain	0	Rested
Cowboy Tanks	0	Rested

Livestock may be turned out on the allotments once resource conditions improve and water availability increases, this will be determined by both you and Mandy Ball. **Please contact Mandy Ball in writing at least 30 days prior to your preferred date for placing livestock on the allotments.** Due to the changes in Section I, Section II is no longer applicable.



Prior to this change in authorization, you had paid your 2018 grazing bill. Any fees paid for the 2018 grazing season for livestock use that is no longer authorized will be credited to your 2019 grazing bill.
