Project Type: Well deepening and solar pump	
Brief Project Summary: The Slate Creek Windmill currently pumps water from a well that is approximately 40' deep. This project would deepen the well to 100'-150' deep and replace the wind driven pump with a solar pump making it more reliable. The H-4 Ranch already has the infrastructure in place for 52,000 gallons of water storage, 17 drinkers and approximately 20 miles of pipeline. The water from this well will have the ability to water 3 allotment pastures.

NEED STATEMENT – PROBLEM ANALYSIS:

This well provides water for a huge area between Hwy 87 and Hwy 188. The well also serves as a back-up water source for an even larger area. This project would make the well and the pump more reliable.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

Provide reliable permanent water to the lower Slate Creek and Cottonwood pastures

Provide a back-up water source to the Old Lady Brunson pasture.

Provide water for 3- 14,000 gallon storage tanks and 1- 10,000 gallon storage tank

Supply continuous water to 17 drinkers

A well drilling contractor will be hired to deepen the well and set-up the solar pump

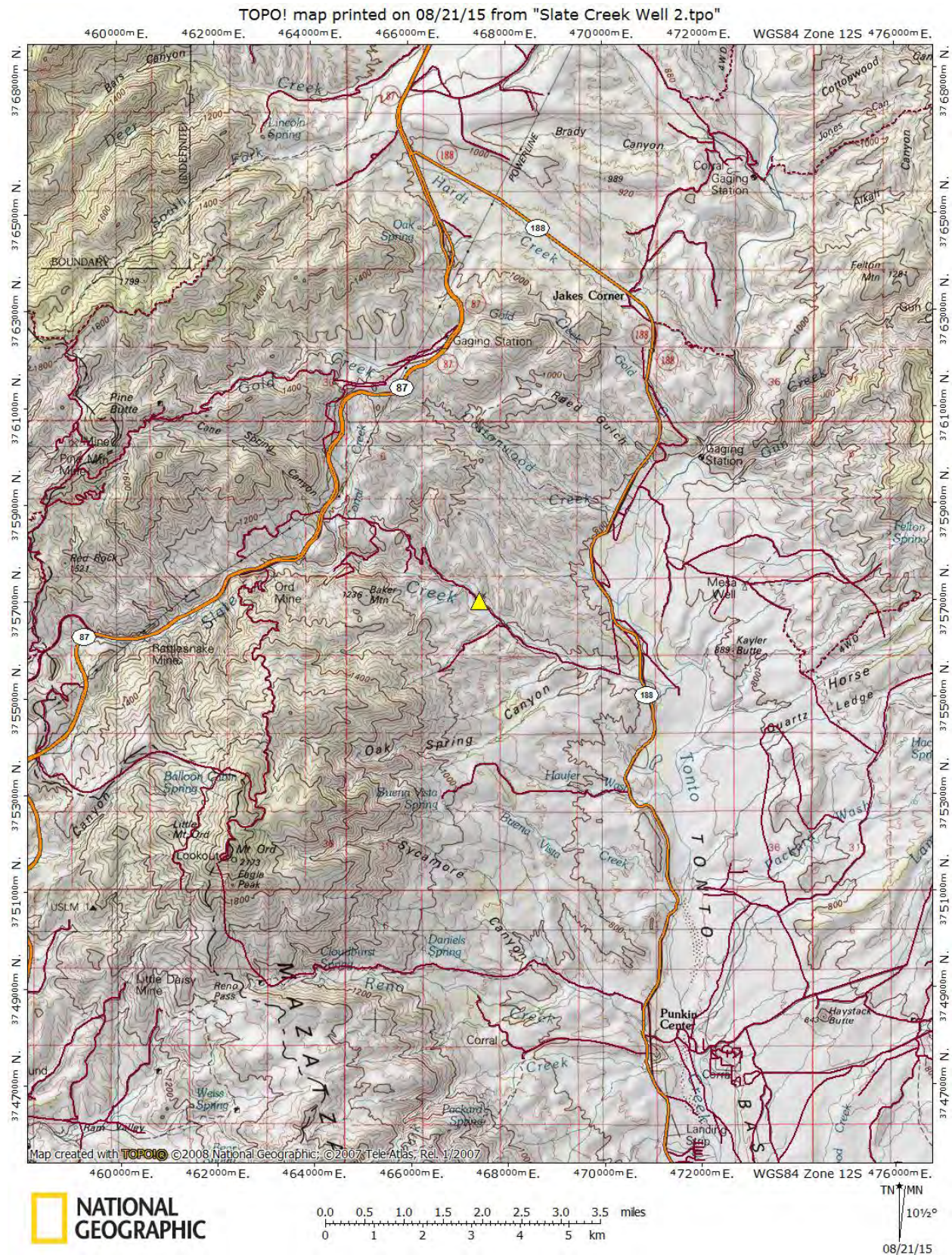

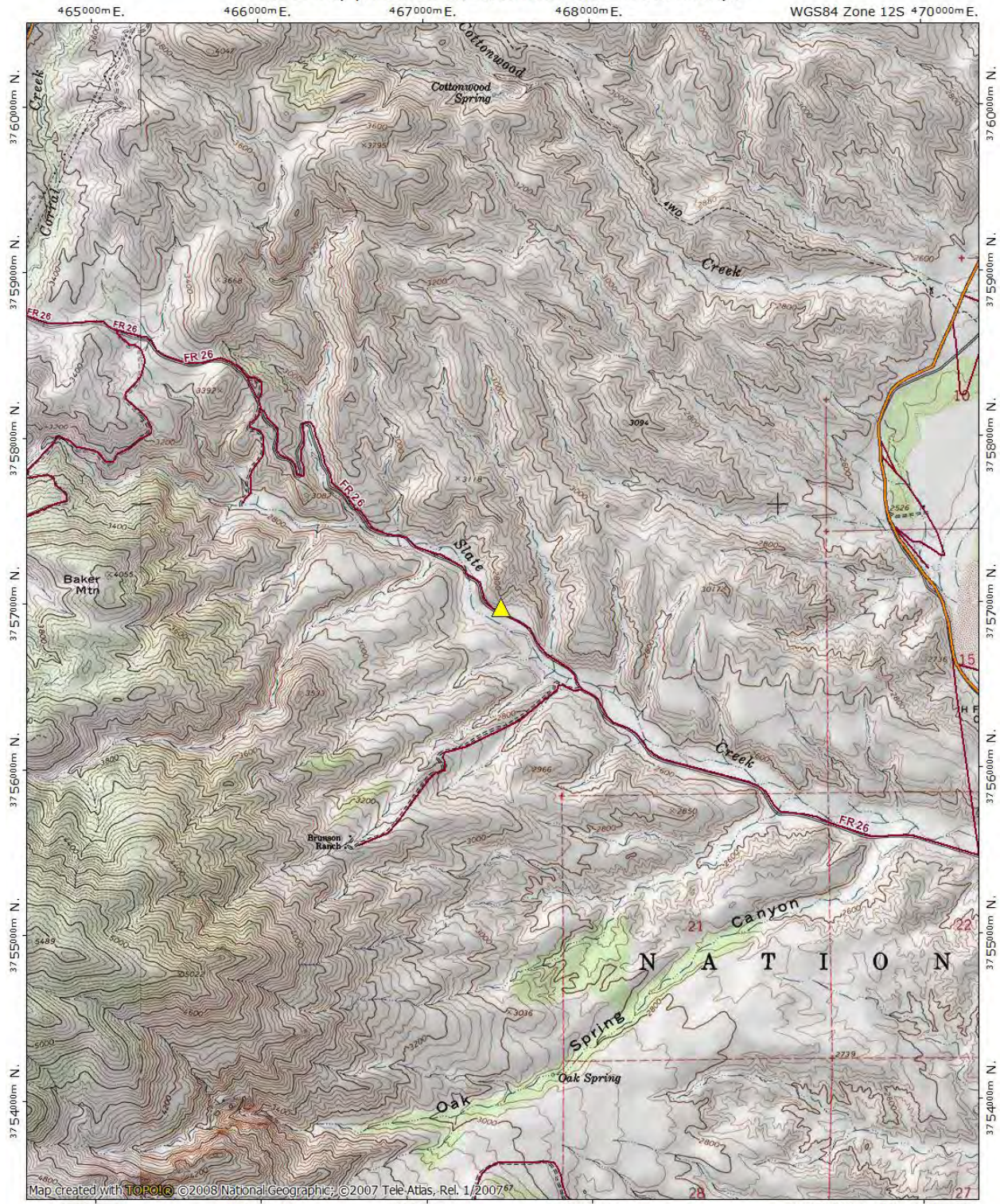
