<b>Brief Project Summary:</b> In 2016, the statewide HPC committed to funding \$100,000.00/year for 5 years to fund the Regional Conservation Partnership Program (RCPP) on the AZ Strip. This proposal represents the request for the third year of this funding. Utilizing the dedicated funding from the HPC for the RCPP, the Department proposes to partner with approximately 10 livestock permittees and the BLM on 8 cooperative catchment facility redevelopments, a water pipeline, and approximately 600 acres of pinyon juniper removal as part of the Uinkaret vegetative management plan.

## PROJECT NEED AND DESCRIPTION

### NEED STATEMENT – PROBLEM ANALYSIS:

In 2017, the BLM completed NEPA analysis for the installation of new wildlife/livestock cooperative catchments across the AZ Strip. In addition, BLM and NPS completed NEPA analysis for the installation of a water pipeline in the Ferry Swale area of game management 12B. Finally, the BLM is currently pending signature on the Uinkaret Vegetative Management Plan (Signature expected October 2017) which will allow vegetative treatment, including pinyon-juniper removal, on approximately 18000 acres on the AZ Strip.

For approximately 5 years the Department has been working closely with the BLM, NRCS, and the respective livestock permittees in the development of these projects, and the associated NEPA.

In 2016, the Department was successful in obtaining a grant through the NRCS's Regional Conservation Partnership Program, RCPP. This program required the Department to provide matching dollars, of which the funding committed through the HPC, is part of the required match.

The implementation of this phase of Department matching dollars, will broaden the footprint of cooperative conservation across the AZ Strip. Water distribution will be improved significantly with the redevelopment or development of approximately 9 cooperative catchment/pipeline facilities in three game management units, and juniper encroachment will be address on approximately 600 acres of BLM lands in game management unit 13A.

Finally, it should be noted that funding received through this proposal will be leveraged with NRCS funding and the Departments Landowner Relations Program funding.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND STRATEGIES:**

The following actions will be pursued with this funding:

**Water Catchment Facilities:**

**Gunsight Catchment Unit 12B:** A new catchment will be installed on BLM lands. Department will provide funding for apron and tank material. NRCS has provided funding for this project.

**Pumphouse Catchment and Pipeline 13B:** A cooperative catchment will be redeveloped to include a new apron for improved collection, a tank lid to prevent drowning of wildlife and to reduce evaporation, and renovation of a pipeline that will supply water to multiple water troughs.

**Ferry Swale Pipeline Unit 12B:** A pipeline will be extended and connected to an existing pipeline to increase water distribution in the Ferry Swale area of unit 12B. This project will improve water distribution resources for pronghorn antelope and other wildlife in the area.

**Water Catchment Tank Lids Units 13A/B and 12B:** Six tank lids will be installed on existing open top 80,000 gallon water storage facilities. The installation of these tank lids will eliminate a drowning hazard for wildlife, significantly reduce evaporation, and provide more water availability and distribution for wildlife and livestock. Each of these lids will be completed using a contractor.

**Vegetative Management Project:**

**Side of the Mountain Chaining Maintenance Unit 13A:** Approximately 600 acres of pinyon juniper removal will occur on BLM lands in southern 13A. Removal will involve the mastication or lop and scatter of juniper trees on a previously treated area where encroachment has reduced wildlife values.
