Dear Daniel and Hannah,

This document serves as Amendment #1 to your 2025 Annual Operating Instructions (AOI) for the Hackberry/Pivot Rock Allotment. This amendment only affects section I. Authorized Livestock Numbers and Section II. Grazing Schedule, to determine the dates and numbers for the remaining grazing year.

I. AUTHORIZED LIVESTOCK NUMBERS/PERIOD OF USE/APPROVED NON-USE

Your 2025 Authorized Use Request has been approved, and you are authorized the following Livestock Numbers and Periods of Use:

220 cows	March 1, 2025 to June 26, 2026
270 cows	June 26, 2025 to November 12 2025
220 cows	November 12, 2025 to February 28, 2026
20 bulls	March 1, 2025 to February 28, 2026
10 horses	March 1, 2025 to February 28, 2026

II. GRAZING SCHEDULE

***Changes from the grazing schedule will be made only with prior Forest Service approval.**

The following is the planned grazing sequence for the Pivot Rock grazing season:

Sandrock	May 1 to May 7	220 cows/20 bulls
Corral	May 8 to May 10	220 cows/20 bulls
27 Mile	May 11 to June 1	220 cows/20 bulls
29 Mile Lake/Pocket/Brush	June 2 to June 25	220 cows/20 bulls
5 Mile/Cinch Hook/Milk Ranch/Baker Lake	June 26 to July 19	270 cows/20 bulls
Potato South	July 20 to Aug 21	270 cows/20 bulls
Potato North	Aug 22 to Sept 26	270 cows/20 bulls



Dry Lake/Clear Creek	Sept 27 to Oct 27	270 cows/20 bulls
Shipping	Oct 28 to Nov 12	270 cows/20 bulls
Horse Rotation		
Neck 2**	June 26 to Nov 12	10 Horses

** Neck 2 will only be grazed if the fencing to the pasture is up to Forest Service Standard.

Rested (Un-grazed) for the 2025 Grazing Season: Teepee, Calloway, Tom's Creek, Bed Bug East and Bed Bug West, Kehl, Miller, Neck pastures, Bald Mesa

The remaining rotation for the 2025-2026 grazing schedule will be determined at a later date depending on fencing and forage availability. The Annual stocking level (annual authorized livestock numbers and dates) are considered approximate. The actual dates and numbers may change due to many variables. Annual stocking level is based on current and expected forage production. The planned use period in a pasture and livestock numbers can/should be adjusted if conditions change, either (shortened or lengthened, depending on forage availability but not in excess of the permitted numbers and utilization in key areas).
