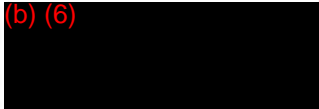

Monitoring:

Upland utilization is measured at the end of the growing season in key areas for key forage species. This information, along with vegetation condition, forage plant production and vigor, soil and watershed condition, will be used to make informed management recommendations concerning pasture moves and stocking rates.

Riparian utilization in key reaches is measured during growing season to verify residual vegetation is present for streambank protection during flow events. Grazing intensity will be evaluated during the growing season to make necessary changes needed for plant development and recovery.

Allowable Use Standards:

Vegetation	Use Threshold
Upland herbaceous species	30-40% of current year's growth
Upland browse species	50% of current year's growth

Salting, Supplements, and Attractants: In most cases, salt must be located no closer than ¼ mile from streams, rivers, riparian areas, trails, and known archaeological sites. Protein blocks, nutritional supplement, and other attractant may be authorized prior to use. No supplemental feeding is authorized, such as hay.

Use of West Ortega pasture is authorized on an emergency basis to respond to the most recent wildfires and drought that has impacted Hicks Pikes Peak allotment. Cattle should be kept off the Salt River. If cattle are seen on Salt River, permittee will be notified and given a week to remove livestock. If livestock are seen again, a mutual plan will be developed to keep livestock off the Salt River. If a *Modification of AOI* is requested, livestock are not authorized in this pasture beyond April 30th.
