Proposal Title: J Bar B Solar Well Conversions Project

Description of Project

Provide financial assistance to convert three existing wells to solar systems. This will allow the three dispersed sites to produce reliable water for wildlife year-round. Previously, they were each operated manually by electric/gasoline generators, only when cattle were present in the pastures. The improved wells will connect to storage tanks and existing pipelines that will feed a total of ten wildlife-friendly drinkers.
