Dear Permittee:

On May 27, 2025, you talked with Andy on the phone to discuss your 2025 Annual Operating Instructions (AOI) for the Lake Mountain Allotment on the Lakeside Ranger District. The pasture rotation and numbers agreed upon are as follows:

<u>Pasture</u>	<u>Numbers</u>	<u>Dates</u>
Reservation	10 cow/calf	June 1 to June 28
Porter/Quakie	10 cow/calf	June 29 to July 16
Firebox	10 cow/calf	July 17 to August 2
Lake Mountain	10 cow/calf	August 3 to September 13
Wolf	10 cow/calf	September 14 to October 4
Doyle/Mineral	10 cow/calf	October 5 to October 31

The desired utilization level for the 2025 grazing season is 25 to 35%. Utilization will be measured on key species in key areas typically after livestock move out of a pasture. Adjustments to this pasture rotation, season of use, or livestock numbers may be needed during the grazing season. Any adjustments need to be coordinated and approved by the Forest Service. When moving between pastures, livestock need to be completely moved out of the pasture within 3 days of the planned rotation date. You must notify the Forest Service in advance if there is a need to deviate from the planned move date.

By this letter, I also authorize you or people working for you to cut, use or remove any trees needed for fence posts and stays for maintenance of structural range improvements within the Lake Mountain Allotment. A copy of this letter must be in possession with you or them while engaged in any tree cutting.

Any range improvement projects and ground disturbing activities need to be coordinated with the Forest Service to make sure all clearances have been obtained before any work can begin on the ground. This process needs to be started well in advance of the proposed work.

This letter will serve as your Annual Operating Instructions for the 2025 grazing year on the Lake Mountain Allotment. In addition, I am always willing to meet with the permittee to hear and discuss any concerns or issues related to these Annual Operating Instructions.
