On May 6, 2019, you and Jonathan met with Kendell and myself to discuss the 2019 Annual Operating Instructions for the Limestone Allotment. The numbers and pasture to be grazed as agreed upon are as follows:

Tentground	40 head	June 1 to September 15

Adjustments to this rotation may be needed during the grazing season. This letter will serve as your Annual Operating Instructions for the 2019 grazing year. The desired utilization level for the 2019 grazing season will be 25% on key species in key areas.

By this letter, I authorize you, or people working for you, to cut or use or remove any trees needed for fence posts and stays for maintenance of structural range improvements on the Limestone Allotment. A copy of this letter must be in possession by you or them while engaged in any tree cutting.
