Dear Troy,

On May 2, 2016, Kendell, Andy and Matt met with you to discuss the 2016 Annual Operating Instructions (AOI) for the Pinyon Allotment. The numbers and rotation authorized are as follows:

Pasture	<u>Numbers</u>	Dates
West	56 cows/calves	June 1 to August 15
East	56 cows/calves	August 16 to October 31

You proposed to run 6 horses on the allotment in conjunction with the cows, which I have authorized for this year. The desired utilization level for 2016 grazing season will be 35% on grasses and forbs across the allotment. Adjustments to this rotation may be needed during the grazing season to accommodate to changing conditions. This letter will serve as your Annual Operating Instructions for the 2016 grazing season.

By this letter, I also authorize you and ranch personnel to cut, use, or remove any trees needed for fence post and stays for maintenance of structural range improvements within the Pinyon Allotment. A copy of this letter must be in possession by you or them while engaged in tree cutting.
