The following are your 2021 annual operating instructions (AOI) for your allotment.

**Authorized Use** Below are authorized livestock numbers per grazing unit, anticipated use dates, and proposed monitoring dates. Please fill out a *Modification of AOI* form in advance of the proposed dates and request approval. Please maintain and submit records that indicate your compliance to permitted use. You are permitted 84 adult cattle yearlong, and 2 horses and 7 bulls 5/1/2021-8/30/2021. You have requested to graze in the Griffin burn scar. Stipulations are listed below.

**Griffin Burn Scar** Reservation pasture is scheduled to be grazed from February 1 through March 13<sup>th</sup>, within Griffin burn scar. In preparation of this AOI, a plan was developed to keep livestock out of the burn scar to allow for recovery that was discussed last year. You agreed to turn off the Southeast pipeline water sources while in Reservation pasture to keep cattle out of the burn scar. The Forest Service will check the burn area regularly. If cattle are seen in the burn area, you will be contacted, and cattle should be moved within 72 hours. If cattle are seen more than 2 times in the burn area, you will be asked to move to your next scheduled pasture. Once cattle have been moved to next pasture, water in Southeast pipeline will be turned back on.

Chrome and Reservation pasture will be evaluated for grazing in the fall and winter after monsoon season. Evaluation will be based several factors, including vegetation response from current precipitation and available forage that has not been impacted by fire.




**Range Improvement Maintenance:** All range improvements must be maintained to Forest Service standards (available at District Office) before cattle will be allowed to enter pastures. It is your responsibility to be aware of and comply with fire restriction.

Reservation	Southeast Pipeline	Fixing piping, trough after fire	Forest Service has requested materials, once received you will be notified for pickup and replacement specifications.
Reservation, Chrome	San Carlos Boundary Fence	T-posts, wire and complete repair of border fence.	Forest Service has requested replacement and labor for some of the fencing damaged by the Griffin fire. You will be notified as this progresses.
Chrome, Richmond	Drought Requested Projects	New Pipeline and new troughs	Forest Service will complete NEPA on these projects and will notify you when installation may begin to respond to drought.




