Dear Chuck:

On April 11, 2016, Andy, Matt, and Kendell met with you and Casey Murph to discuss the 2016 Annual Operating Instructions (AOI) for the Sponseller and Ortega Allotments. The two allotments will be run together by one herd with a rest rotation schedule. The pasture rotation and numbers are listed below:

| Sponseller | East Sponseller | 386 Head | August 14 to September 10 |
| Sponseller | South Sponseller | 386 Head | September 11 to October 2 |
| Sponseller | West Sponseller | 386 Head | October 3 to October 10 |
| Sponseller | Holding Pastures | 386 Head | October 11 to October 28 |
| Ortega | East Mormon | 14 Bulls | June 24 to October 31 |

The Bourdon Pasture will be rested this year while they continue vegetation treatments. The desired utilization level for the 2016 grazing season will be 35% for all pastures. Adjustments to this rotation may be needed during the grazing season. By this letter, I also authorize you or Casey to cut, use or remove any trees needed for fence posts and stays for maintenance of structural range improvements within the Sponseller and Ortega Allotments. A copy of this letter must be in possession by you or Casey while engaged in any tree cutting.

Discussed at the meeting was the progress that has taken place on vegetation treatments within the Bourdon Pasture. They will continue working in this pasture over the summer and most likely into the fall. The Bourdon Well windmill blew over this spring and caused damage to the wiring and water lines. You are currently working to get that well functioning again. We also talked about the Mexican Gray Wolf re-introduction program and how that may affect you in the future. The Fish and Wildlife service has representatives for the wolf program that are available to meet with you if you have any additional questions or concerns. Kendell talked about the ongoing 4-Fri (Four Forests Restoration Initiative) analysis that encompasses mainly the Sponseller Allotment. The analysis is currently being worked on and implementation of vegetation treatments is still unknown at this time.

This letter will serve as your Annual Operating Instructions for the 2016 grazing year for the Sponseller and Ortega Allotments.
