This letter from the Clifton Ranger District Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests is amending your current Annual Operating Instructions (AOI) to reflect your request of changing the season of use in all pastures listed below. Recent forage data that you have collected and shared with the Range Program shows sufficient forage to extend the use in Deerhead East and Deerhead Trap an additional month. This AOI amendment is hereby made a part of the Term Grazing Permit. The table below shows the amendment (highlighted in yellow) of your 2024 Annual Operating Instructions.
