Dear Permittee:

On May 6th, 2024, Andy met with you to discuss the 2024 Annual Operating Instructions for the Willow Wash Allotment. The pasture rotation and numbers agreed upon are as follows:

<u>Pasture</u>	<u>Head</u>	<u>Dates</u>
West Sundown	11 C/C	May 1 to June 2
East Sundown	11 C/C	June 3 to June 23
SE Willow	11 C/C	June 24 to July 7
Sackett	11 C/C	July 8 to July 21
Phelps	11 C/C	July 22 to August 5
Hall	11 C/C	August 6 to August 19
Bear Springs	11 C/C	August 20 to September 3
Yarrow	11 C/C	September 4 to September 15
Ranch	11 C/C	September 16 to September 30
NW Willow	11 C/C	October 1 to October 20
SW Willow	11 C/C	October 21 to November 10
NE Willow	11 C/C	November 11 to November 30

The desired utilization level for the 2024 grazing season will be 25% on herbaceous forage species, 20% of terminal buds on riparian trees, and 45% on browse species. Utilization monitoring will take place on key species within key areas when livestock leave the pasture.

Adjustments to this rotation may be needed during the grazing season. Any adjustments to the rotation need to be coordinated and approved by Forest Service one week prior to the scheduled move date. When moving between pastures, livestock need to be completely moved out of the pasture within 3 days of the planned rotation date. You must notify the Forest Service if there is a need to deviate away from the planned move date.

By this letter, I also authorize you, or people working for you, to cut, use or remove any trees needed for fence posts and stays for maintenance of structural range improvements within the Willow Wash Allotment. A copy of this letter must be in possession with you while engaged in any tree cutting.
